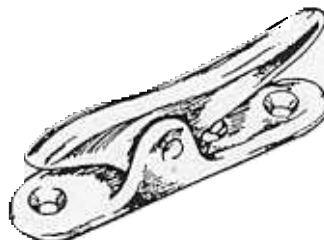
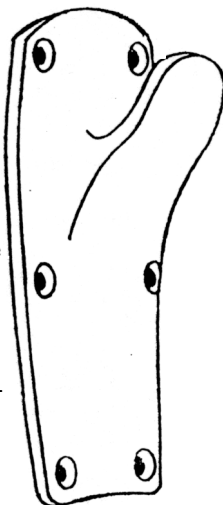


HMO064 SMALL RIGGING CLEAT

The best type of standing rigging is where the stay is spliced into an eye around the mast. A Rigging Cleat also called a Thumb Cleat or Hound was used on the opposite side of the mast to keep the eye from slipping down. These cleats have openings that will support 1/4", 3/8", 7/16" and 1/2" wire rope.



OSBORNE RACING CLEAT

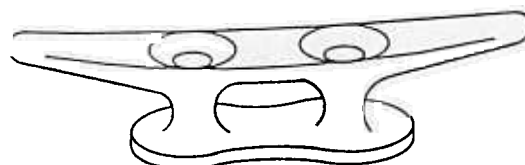
This unique type of jamb cleat is designed for use on both horizontal and vertical surfaces. This is a very quick action cleat that jams the line with a toggle action, it was once used by the U.S. Navy on signal halyards.

 BB0696 5 1/4" long 1 1/8" wide 1/2" line



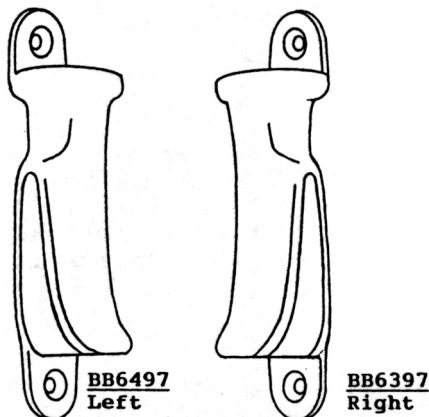
PEDESTAL CLEAT

Pedestal cleats are general utility cleats with plenty of length to take off numerous turns of a line. BB7195 is 4" long, 3/4" wide and uses #10 screws. BB7295 is 5" long, 3/4" wide base and uses #12 screws.



DOUBLE PEDESTAL CLEAT

This beautiful, very strong cleat is for general utility work. Of traditional design it allows ample space for lines. BB6697 is 3" long with a 1 1/2" long base. BB8197 is 7 1/2" long with a 2 1/2" long base.



TUBE CLEATS are a very quick action light duty jamb cleat. Able to handle up to 3/8" line, the line runs thru the tube and can be jammed into the slot in the side of the cleat where it is held securely.



BB2292 HORN CLEAT

This small utility cleat has a base measurement of 1" X 1 1/2" and is 2 3/4" long.



BB3094 Spar Cleat

Spar cleats are popular due to their low profile. They are usually used for clew outhaul and topping lift lines. BB3094 is 3 1/2" long and 1/2" high.
