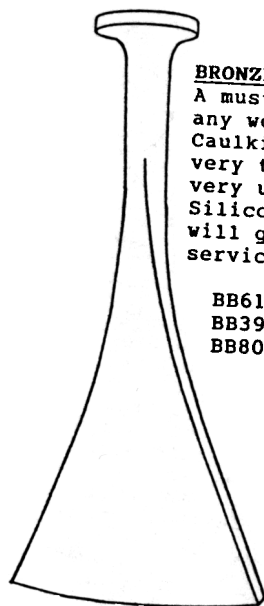
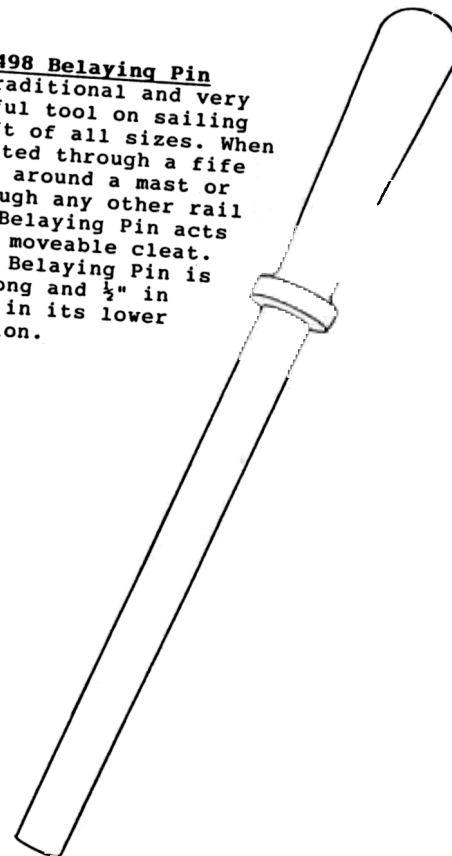


BB7497 MARLINSPIKE

Also known as a "fid" this useful tool is a must for any traditional boater that can splice his own lines. Used to open the lay of a line for splicing this tool measures 8" long and tapers from 39/64" just under the head to a flat point at the lower end.

BB0498 Belaying Pin

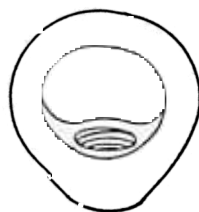
A traditional and very useful tool on sailing craft of all sizes. When mounted through a fife rail around a mast or through any other rail the Belaying Pin acts as a moveable cleat. This Belaying Pin is 9" long and 1/2" in Dia. in its lower section.

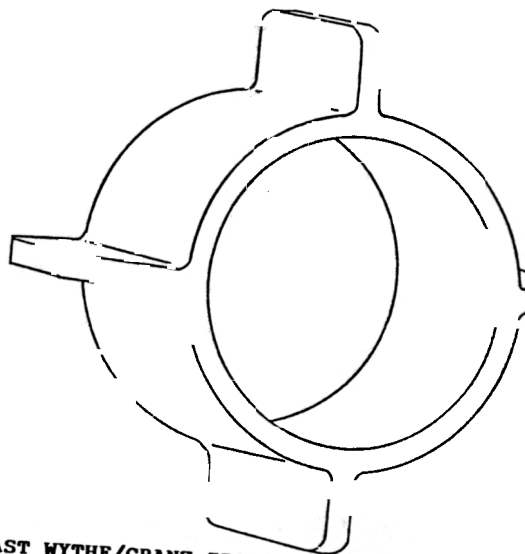

PORT LIGHT DOG

This is the hand grip that is used to screw a port light closed.

- BB2095 2" O.D. 1 1/2" I.D.
 7/16 - 14 thread
- BB2296 1 1/2" O.D. 7/8" I.D.
 1/2" - 13 thread



MAST WYTHE/CRANZ IRON

A Mast Wythe sits at the top of a mast and is the attachment point for the upper stays. A Cranz Iron performs the same function for the stays at the end of the bow sprit.
